

**LETTER OF INTENT  
BETWEEN  
THE MINISTRY OF MARINE AFFAIRS AND FISHERIES  
OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA  
AND THE AUTONOMY GOVERNMENT OF GALICIA  
OF THE KINGDOM OF SPAIN  
ON FISHERIES COOPERATION**

**The Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries of the Republic of Indonesia and the Autonomy Government of Galicia of the Kingdom of Spain, motivated by intention to enhance friendly cooperation between two parties;**

**Considering** that the Autonomy Government of Galicia has market access to Europe, and the Republic of Indonesia has market access to regional and international;

**Desiring** to promote cooperation through implementing activities in the fields of marine and fisheries that would lead to mutual benefits on economic development of two parties;

**Do hereby** declare their intention to establish a fishery cooperation and have agreed as follows:

1. This Letter of Intent aims to promote efficient and effective business activities of producers and distributors in the fields of fisheries sector.
2. The two parties intent to develop and pursue the following areas of cooperation, inter alia :
  - a. Education and training for fishers and aqua-culturists.
  - b. To enhance the existing cooperation between two parties on fishing vessel and human resources development.
  - c. Promoting cooperation development, especially through agreement on providing representatives, distribution, and strategy to technology application.
  - d. Promoting participation of fisheries and aquaculture companies in the various activities such as exhibition and exposition.
  - e. Promoting participation and exchange of technology through effective programs and special assistance.
  - f. Promoting participation in fishery development projects, increment of fishery production, and quality control of fishery products.
  - g. Assisting preparation of meetings, seminars and special exhibitions.
  - h. Promoting trade exchange, investment and cooperation projects through special mission.
3. The two parties intent to establish a Bipartite Committee, which its members will be in equal level, to ensure the implementation of this Letter of Intent within three months after signing of the Letter of Intent.

4. The two parties through the Bipartite Committee will determine in detail the cooperation schemes, ways, and actions programs to implement of the mentioned areas of cooperation under point two.
5. The Bipartite Committee will coordinate, monitor and facilitate cooperation in the field of fisheries activities under the framework of this Letter of Intent.
6. The two parties will support the cooperative activities pursuant to the Letter of Intent and in accordance with the relevant policies, law and regulation applicable to each party, within the limits of competence and available financial resources.

**Done** in Santiago de Compostela, Galicia, Spain, on the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of April in the year two thousand and five, in Spanish and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
