

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding relating to the joint demarcation and survey of the common land boundary between Malaysia and the Republic of Indonesia signed at Jakarta on the 26 November 1973 and in accordance with:

- (a) The Boundary Convention signed at London dated 20 June 1891;
- (b) The Boundary Agreement signed at London dated 28 September 1915; and
- (c) The Boundary Convention signed at the Hague dated 26 March 1928,

the Joint Malaysia - Indonesia Boundary Committee hereby agrees to the following :

1. The Areas that have been demarcated and surveyed by the Joint Malaysia - Indonesia Survey Teams in the Sarawak - Kalimantan Timur Sector are as follow:
