

**LETTER OF INTENT
BETWEEN
THE INDONESIAN NATIONAL POLICE
AND
THE LAW ENFORCEMENT FORCE OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC
OF IRAN
ON
POLICE COOPERATION**

The Indonesian National Police and the Law Enforcement Force of the Islamic Republic of Iran, hereinafter referred to as "The Parties";

Desiring to strengthen and improve the existing friendly and cooperative relations between the two countries;

Expressing their concern and recognition of the threat increasingly posed by crime;

Recognizing mutual trust benefit and principals on international cooperation, as enshrined in the United Nations Charter and the other universal recognized norms in international law such as equal sovereignty and respect to territorial integrity of both countries;

Pursuant to the prevailing laws and regulations in their respective countries;

Have declared their intention as follows:



Paragraph 1

Objective

The objective of this Letter of Intent (LOI) is to establish an initial framework of cooperation between the Parties to mutually assist each other in police cooperation.

Paragraph 2

Areas of Cooperation

The Parties will cooperate, in accordance with their respective national laws and regulations and based on the principle of reciprocity and mutual consent in various fields of police cooperation.

Paragraph 3

Forms of Cooperation

For the purpose of implementation of this LOI the Parties will:

- Exchange of information and experiences on matters related to policing;
- Support capacity building through the exchange of personnel, sharing of knowledge and experience, and education and training programs.

Paragraph 4

Expenses

Expenses arising from the implementation of this LOI will be borne by the respective Parties, unless agreed otherwise by the Parties.



Paragraph 5
Confidentiality


The Parties will maintain the confidentiality of information exchanged under this LOI and use such information only for the purposes it was submitted for. Neither Party may communicate or pass such information to a third party without the written consent of the Party providing the information.

Paragraph 6
Disputes Settlement

Any divergence in interpretation or performance of this LOI will be settled through negotiations between the competent authorities of the Parties and through diplomatic channels.

Paragraph 7
Entry into Force, Duration, and Termination

The implementation of this LOI will be carried out in due course in the form of specific Memorandum of Understanding.
